PACES Project is Co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union.

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

## Progression of Accessibility Centres in higher Education for Students with disabilities in North Africa

The influencer starts her video with an interview with Prof. Aziz Kribii, the director of UIT Accessibility Centre. Prof. Aziz provided a historical sketch of the objective and establishment of the Centre. He also showed and explained all kind of services available and assistive technologies provided for the students with disabilities. The Centre is the fruit of two EU funded projects SWING and PACES:



- 1. SWING: Sustainable Ways to Increase higher educatioN students (equal access to learninG environments, which was funded by TEMPUS in the duration of 2011-2015
- 2. PACES: Progression of Accessibility Centers in higher Education for Students with disabilities in north Africa which was funded by Erasmus Plus in the duration of 2017-2021



- The video showcases the challenges that these students went through in their lives;
- 1. Oumaima is 26 years old and a Master of Arts holder. She expressed that she had the courage to establish herself as an independent person who has always rejected the denigrating view of her entourage. Since, then she joined the national golf competition for people with disabilities.

**2. Reda** is 33 years old and a Master of Arts holder. He is currently a PhD student and a World Champion in many sports competitions. He shared that during his studying journey he always managed to succeed in the written exam but he failed in the oral exam due to his disability. He stressed that he have managed to overcome the hardships of life and the stereotypical view of society. He is currently an administrator at the School of Humanities in Kenitra.

**3.** Assim is the first foreign student (Sudanese) with a visual disability to hold a PhD degree in Morocco. He was faculty member back in Sudan before moving

into Morocco to pursue his graduate studies. He has declared that disability is a motivator to excel in what One Does
